

Explanations regarding the Student Personal Data Form

The student personal data form is designed to determine which canton is responsible for funding your studies according to the Intercantonal Agreement on the Universities of Applied Sciences.

Since large sums of money are involved in funding your studies, please make sure that you answer all questions accurately.

As soon as an answer refers you to a listed item (A, B, C, D, E1, E2) on the back of the form, no further questions need to be answered. If you have any queries, please consult the contact person at your university or college.

Persons from the Principality of Liechtenstein have the same rights as Swiss nationals and are therefore not regarded as foreign nationals.

All confirmations of residency submitted must be originals. They must be dated no more than 3 months prior to the commencement of your studies. A settlement permit is not valid as confirmation of residency.

¹ commencement of studies:

The official start date of a semester at a university of applied sciences is the first day of calendar week 8 for the spring semester and calendar week 38 for the autumn semester.

² parents or holders of parental authority:

- Parents or holders of parental authority refers to your father or mother. It is not necessary to provide confirmation of
 residency for both parents. If your parents live in different cantons, enclose confirmation of residency for the parent who
 had the sole parental authority until your majority or in case of joint parental authority for the parent with whom you
 mainly lived.
- If this parent's name is different from your own name, please enclose a copy of an official document confirming the parental status.

³ financially independent (question 2):

- The factor determining financial independence is a period of at least 24 months during which you were **financially independent** of your parents, i.e. you had your own income which was sufficient to cover your basic needs (living expenses, rent, tuition fees, etc.).
- In order to prove that you were financially independent, you are required to give details of your employment (name of employer) or other form of occupation.
- Other forms of occupation include running a household, completing military service, receiving unemployment benefits, disability benefits or social welfare, completing an internship (but not as part of a programme of study), etc. Unpaid holiday is not considered to interrupt this period of 24 months as long as you continued to be financially independent of your parents; however, unpaid holiday of this kind must be listed under item D.
- An internship is classified as employment rather than formal training if you were financially independent of your parents during this time.
- 'prior to the commencement of your studies' does not mean that the period of financial independence must have taken place immediately before you begin your studies. It can have taken place earlier. Time spent doing an apprenticeship is not classified as financial independence.

⁴ 24 consecutive months (question 3):

The determining factor is whether your place of residence under civil law was in the same canton for at least 24 months during the period in which you were financially independent. If you were resident in more than one canton during this time, please enter the canton in which you resided during the time closest to the commencement of your studies.

Please enclose confirmation of residency from the municipality in which you were resident for the most recent period of 24 consecutive months before the commencement of your studies. If you were resident in more than one municipality in the same canton during this time, please enclose confirmation of residency for each of the municipalities concerned.

⁶ Question 7:

- If one of your parents lives in Switzerland, please answer 'no'.
- If you have more than one place of origin, the first-named place of origin applies. Otherwise, the last place of origin in which citizenship was acquired applies.

Questions 8 and 10:

- The term "under guardianship" concerns
- a. persons under the age of 18 who due to a child protection measure are or were not placed under parental authority,
- b. persons over the age of 18 who are placed under an adult protection measure.

SUPSI Question 11:

- You are considered to have a place of residence under civil law in Switzerland if the place where you live is your
 primary residence. As a rule, a settlement permit or a residence permit which has not been issued solely for the
 purpose of your studies is considered proof of your place of residence under civil law.
- If this applies to you, please answer 'yes' to question 11 and fill in item C on the back of the personal data form. Otherwise, answer 'no' and fill in item F.

Information on the wording of Article 5 of the Intercantonal Agreement on Universities of Applied Sciences (FHV)

Canton of residency

The student's canton of residency is defined as:

- a. the canton of origin for Swiss nationals whose parents live abroad or who live abroad and are parentless; in the event of there being more than one canton of origin, the last in which citizenship was acquired applies.
- b. the designated canton for political refugees and stateless persons who have reached the age of majority and whose parents are both deceased or live abroad; subject to point d
- c. the canton in which residence under civil law is held by foreign nationals who have reached the age of majority and whose parents are both deceased or live abroad; subject to point d.
- d. the canton in which students who have reached the age of majority have lived for at least two consecutive years, during which period they were financially independent without being simultaneously enrolled on a programme of study; gainful employment includes running a household or completing military service.
- e. in all other case, the canton where the parents' place of residence under civil law is located at the time the programme of study commences or the canton in which the Child and Adult Protection Authority (KESB) most recently responsible is located.

Decision of the Conference of member cantons of the Intercantonal Agreement on Universities of Applied Sciences (FHV) of June 27th 2019:

- 1. Article 5 lit. d FHV is to be interpreted as focusing on the two characteristics of financial independence and simultaneous uninterrupted residence in a canton. The training status of the students (with the exception of basic vocational training), however, is neglected.
- 2. The regulation becomes effective immediately. The cantons and the educational institutes are granted a transition period until spring semester 2020 at the latest. In controversial cases the new regulation applies.

Text of Art. 10 of the Directives for invoicing, within the scope of the Intercantonal Agreement for Universities of Applied Arts and Sciences (ASUP), of 12 June 2003 (version 30 April, 2021)

Canton required to pay contributions

Art. 10 ¹The Canton of domicile decided at the start of the course, on the basis of the personal information questionnaire, must in principle pay the contributions for the full duration of the study programme.

²The Canton required to pay the contributions must be decided once again:

- each time a student changes university,
- each time studies are interrupted (and enrolment withdrawn).

³This means that it may change in the following cases:

- transfer from a Bachelor's programme to a Master's programme at another university (direct transfer to a Master's programme at the same university is not cause for change),
- move to another university, with or without interruption in studies,
- recommencement of studies at the same university after an interruption involving withdrawal of enrolment, (with or without changing degree course).
